Community Centre Advisory Committee (2021-2022) Election

Background

Caritas Community Centres provides full-range social services to residents of the districts they situated. Each Centre has its own Advisory Committee, regulating the operation and monitoring the efficiency and efficacy of the centre's Social Welfare Department subvented services.

The Advisory Committee also serves as the platform for the local residents and stakeholders to participate in the community. It increases the participation of the Centre's members; strengthens the Centre's accountability; responds to the local need and provides better service for the community.

The Advisory Committee is constituted of 5 Elected Members, 5 Appointed Members, Representative of the Catholic Church, and 3 Representatives of the Caritas-Hong Kong. The Committee Election will be held biennially, and all members who is aged above 18 and bears the valid membership card is eligible to cast the vote in this election.

Election procedures

All 18-year-old or above valid members can vote in the election. **For those who are born between 21 November and 4 December of 2002, please come to vote after your birthday during the polling period.**

For Voters

- There are a ballot paper (pink), a ballot-sealing envelope (yellow), and an envelope for mail (white) enclosed in this mail. Please check your membership number printed on the envelope for mail. If it is not appropriate, please call 2816 8025 for our Social Work Supervisor, Ms. Anna Kwok for follow up.



- Please put a “✓” in the circle next to the name of your favourite candidates, **you can vote for a maximum of FIVE candidates.** Ballot paper with more than five “✓” or any other symbols or characters will be deemed as invalid.
- Please put your completed ballot paper into the YELLOW envelope, and seal. Please do not mark anything on the Yellow envelope, or it will be deemed as invalid as well.
- Please put the YELLOW envelope into the WHITE envelope, seal and post to the Centre with no stamp.
- **Please post on or before 4 December 2020, all ballot received after 5:00 pm on 9 December 2020 (Wednesday) will be voided.**
